The Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America, Alaska Chapter (AAFA Alaska) considers your health and safety to be our top priority. For our 15th Annual Asthma & Allergy Conference, we are planning a safe program that follows CDC guidelines, as well as state and municipal health mandates.

With this in mind, AAFA Alaska provides the following information about the COVID-19 precautions we may implement for *Wheezin,' Sneezin' & Itchin' in Alaska* 2021.

- 1. Social distancing.** We will use two learning rooms simultaneously to allow for a social distanced seating configuration.
- 2. Dining precautions.** Instead of a buffet line, meal options may be plated or boxed to avoid congested gathering.
- 3. Face covering.** Wearing masks may be required.
- 4. Vaccination.** Attendees must have completed COVID vaccination or provide proof of antibodies or a negative PCR test within 48 hours. We reserve the right to request proof of vaccination.
- 5. Virtual option.** Virtual attendance may need to be an option if municipal mandates require reduced attendance.
